

Call for Nominations – 2012 ACS Langmuir Lecturers

The *ACS Division of Colloid and Surface Chemistry*, along with the ACS journal *Langmuir*, are currently soliciting nominations for the 2012 Langmuir Lecturers. Each year since 1979, two outstanding scientists have been chosen as Langmuir Lecturers from the international scientific community based on their outstanding research, publications, and creativity in the interdisciplinary field of Colloid, Interfacial, and Surface Chemistry.

Each Langmuir Lecturer will deliver a plenary lecture in a special session of the Colloid and Surface Chemistry Division program at the 2012 Fall ACS Meeting to be held in Denver, Colorado. The Lecturers will each receive a \$3000 honorarium, a plaque, free registration to the 2012 ACS Fall Meeting, and travel reimbursement. Additionally, Lecturers will submit a lecture manuscript for publication in *Langmuir*, subject to peer review.

Winners will be selected by a committee that includes the ACS Colloid and Surface Chemistry Division Chair and Chair-elect, and the Editor-in-Chief of *Langmuir*.
